Class observation

Dance classes are closed to observers, including parents and siblings.

Children gain confidence and independence when granted the freedom to attain goals by means of their own efforts. Participation in educational and artistic activities within a structured, controlled environment will aid the development of these qualities.

Young children require a quiet area free from distraction in order to focus on their dancing and perform to their best ability. I aim to create a productive and peaceful environment where a high level of involvement, expression and dance can be achieved.

Young children adapt to new situations or classes in different ways e.g. by crying or not participating. This behaviour may last for a couple of minutes or for several classes. Your teacher is very experienced with young children and can manage the behaviour. The presence of the parent or care giver for a short time at the first class may be appropriate in some instances, however often the child will join the group more quickly without parent involvement.

Open days will be held each term during the usual class time for parents to observe the progress of their child. Cameras or videos recorders are welcome. During open days please turn mobile telephones off and remain quietly in the room for the duration of the class to allow the dancers to perform well.

Grandparents or special visitors to Dubai who are unable to visit on open days may observe classes at the discretion of the teacher – please ask.
